
# DESIGN PROCESS

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Eventing is best described as an equestrian triathlon. The sport originated as a cavalry test and is comprised of three phases: dressage, cross-country, and show jumping. Eventing tests horse and rider pairs more completely than any other.

The first phase - dressage - shows the graceful partnership of horse and rider through a sequence of movements on the flat. The next phase - cross-country - challenges the pair's bravery, fitness, and determination as combinations navigate a series of solid obstacles and varied terrain. In the final phase - show jumping - pairs must again prove their precision as they clear a course of delicate fences. Competitors accumulate penalty points in each phase, and at the end of the event, the pair with the lowest score takes home top honors.

Held over one, two, or three days, eventing is one of the few Olympic sports where men and women compete alongside one another as equals.

The United States Eventing Association (USEA) is the national organization dedicated to the education and development of horses and riders in the sport of eventing.

Formerly the United States Combined Training Association (USCTA), the USEA has over 13,000 members in all 50 states as well as over 250 national recognized competitions nearly year round.





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Food for Champs addresses the general need for better food options at events. A food truck business that caters specifically to the eventing community by following the local show circuit, provides a convenient and fresh solution.

### Persona I

Jenny is a 33 year old woman who is married with two children. Her family avidly supports her riding and generally attends the events with her. Jenny is fairly new to the sport and sometimes finds herself lost in the excitement and business of the events. The FFC app helps her to remember her ride times. She can also share her schedule with her partner, so that they know where they can find her next. While the app helps her to stay on time, she also finds it convenient to order her meal and have her partner pick it up for her.



#### Persona 2

As a 40 year old man, Doug is an avid eventer with many horses in training and generally competing on more than one. While his horses are at different stages of training, he must juggle multiple ride times. Doug finds the FFC app to be helpful for inputing his personal ride schedule, as well as his student's schedules. Due to his busy schedule at shows he hardly has the time to prepare or get a meal. Food for Champs is convenient to him as it is located right on show grounds and he is able to pick up food and drinks between rides.

#### Persona 3

Lucy is a 24 year old woman who has been eventing since she was a teenager. She mainly attends events independently and competes with one horse. Lucy uses the FFC app to confirm that the food truck will be at the next show she goes to. She particularily likes Food for Champs because the stickers are cool, the snacks are tasty and healthy, and they have the coffee she likes.

Food for Champs is a traveling food truck. The FFC food truck will provide fresh and sustaining food for competitors and spectators alike. The menu features food that is customizable, healthy, fresh and convenient. The main item is a custom sandwich or wrap built to your liking and also offered as a meal. In addition, healthy smoothies, quick snacks, and a variety of drinks are also sold at the truck.

In partnership with the food truck, a Food for Champs app is available. The app utilizes Artificial Intelligence (AI) through schedule input, reminders and predictions. The app will be useful for keeping track of ride times, particularily when managing multiple horses or students. Including the abilitiy to set reminders ahead of scheduled events. Another benefit of the app is the order ahead function. Maximizing efficiencey by customizing the order, setting a pickup time and paying ahead.









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
# FOOD TRUCK

With in the app though, customers can customize their orders and schedule when they want to pick them up.






### АI


